F. Internet sources in the field of comparative constitutional law

There are a couple of internet sources which are helpful for the orientation and gathering of information in the field of comparative constitutional law. In particular, the constitutions of most countries and English translations are available at the websites of the national parliaments, governments, presidents or constitutional courts. Often these websites also inform in brief about the constitutional status, missions, competences and functioning of these institutions. Constitutional jurisprudence is usually published on the websites of the constitutional courts, important decisions often with English translation. Furthermore, there are several online journals of comparative constitutional law, expert sites of university institutes and blogs of individual researchers. See the links on the special website for this course.

Make sure that you only use websites with reliable, thorough and up-to-date legal information for your legal research! Be aware that articles from Common Law countries, though written in English, may be addressed to domestic readers only and do not necessarily reflect the newest developments in the international discussion in legal science. Furthermore, be aware of the language problem: Legal texts from continental legal systems are difficult to translate accurately into English because this language often lacks the necessary legal terminology. In detail, even official translations are often unprecise, misleading or wrong. If possible, refer also to the original text, use a credible translation and/or verify it with the help of someone who knows the language well.
